It will also be linked to and supply food to the Kendal Peoples Cafe. If you feel you can help contact us and have a chat about possibilities to suit the time you have available. We plan on developing a team for each role so there is no need to be available all the time. There will be support and teamwork. This is a great opportunity to meet and work alongside others.

## **VOLUNTEERS NEEDED**

### **Food Collection and Deliveries (Days Flexible)**

To arrange collection of food from selected supermarkets and shops, plus delivery to the Food Hub. Although initially on a Thursday this could be changed to other days as food storage and distribution becomes more established.

### **Food & Stores - Inventory monitoring and Freezer management (Any day)**

This role involves setting up and then monitoring a system of managing food as it arrives at the hub and then its subsequent distribution and storage.

### **Store Food Arrival and distribution (Thursday)**

Monitoring arrival and distribution of fresh food plus assessing which is moved to the freezers.
