### 6) Lecture from Mike Berners-Lee (*There is no Planet B*, Cambridge Uni. Press 2019)

• One hour lecture on the climate change impacts of food followed by questions from the floor. Talk with powerpoints covered global energy use; global supply of human edible food vs. edible food going to animals and biofuels; carbon footprint of beef vs. tofu; food miles and how we transport our food. Malnutrition and stresses on the global supply presented as problems of distribution, not production. The lecture also reviewed food industry challenges and solutions; the importance of truth (what does it mean, when we say "No waste to landfill"? Inaccurate claims – "A third of UK energy comes from renewables") and a need for new values to reboot society and economy on sustainable lines (c.f. global movement for change, Extinction Rebellion, and reasons for hope such as education and children campaigning for change, etc).
